CIVIL CONSTRUCTION OF NEW 11Kv ADAMSTOWN ZONE SUBSTATION

Contract Value: \$3,845,000

Client: Ausgrid

Gongues Constructions were awarded the contract for the Civil and Building Construction work for the New Adamstown 33kV Zone Substation in October 2008.

Adamstown consisted of a combined Control Room/Switch room, two Capacitor Rooms, two AF Rooms, one Battery Room and two Transformer Bays.

The site was located in a residential area, close to main roads and essential infrastructure and services; however Gongues were able to efficiently and productively manage the project.

This project also included the construction of several footings and the installation of conduits in the adjacent existing Merewether Sub-transmission Substation. All Gongues employees are EA Live Substation Trained.

Through concise coordination and clear communication with the client Energy Australia, EJE Architecture and Lindsay and Dynan Engineers, Gongues were able to complete the project on schedule in 7 months.
